Activating the trigger carelessly is extremely dangerous. Never put your finger onto the trigger unless the safety cap is removed and you are ready to shoot a target.



When shooting the air guns for target practice When shooting the air guns for target practice or in a game situation, you and all participants must wear goggles or other eye protective gear Also, pay attention to ricochets.
It is important to pay attention to third parties other than the participants.

There may be cases where some BBs remain in the gun after the magazine has been disconnected.


After removal of the magazine, direct the muzzle towards a safe direction and pull the trigger to confirm that no BBs remain in the gun, then attach the safety cap.

When you carry the air gun, attach the safety cap, set the selector lever to the safety position and always put it in a case or bag.



Always attach the safety cap to the muzzle, remove the battery and store the air gun in a case or bag and at a place out of reach by children.




Never direct the muzzle towards a person animal or in any other dangerous direction.

Make sure to attach the barrel and safety cap to Make sure to attach the barrel and safety cap to the muzzle, except when you are shooting. Do this to prevent accidental, sudden discharge and also for dust protection purposes. NEVER pull the trigger while the barrel and the safety cap is attached.




Safety procedure

- 1 Attach the safety cap to the muzzle.
  2 Set the selector lever to the safety position.
  3 Remove the magazine.
  4 Remove the battery.



Looking into the muzzle is extremely dangerous regardless of BB's having been loaded or not. If you get hit in the eye by a BB bullet, you may in worst case, loose your eye sight.







# A warning!! Before the Field stripping

- 1. Check the gun a safety direction and remove magazine.
- 2. Place the safety on "safe mode".
- Pull the charging handle all the way to the rear, and inspect the chamber to ensure it is empty.
- 4. Do not operate the trigger, leave the hammer cocked and the gun on safe.

## TROUBLESHOOTING To dismiss the easy bugs

SYMPTOM	CAUSE	SOLVING
No operation at all	Battery is not charged	Charged the battery
	The ⊞ and ⊟ connector is reversed	Connect the connector in right way. (see page 8 and page 9)
	Fuse is damaged	Replace the fuse. (see page 10)
	Motor is not moving	Replace the motor or check and replace the electrical connector.
	Motor is damaged	(Purchasing from your dealer or G&G)
Gun can't fire	BBs are jammed in the chamber	Stop pulling the trigger immediately and take out the magazine to clean out any BBs that are jammed. Use the cleaning rod and clean out any left over BBs. Make sure there are no left-over BBs inside the hop-up rubber.
	Faulty gear	Replace the replacement gear. (Purchasing from your dealer or G&G)

If the gun gets wet	Stop the operation immediately, disconnect the battery and field stripping the gun. Wipe off water from inside the receiver, motor, gear box and other parts, then wait complete drying for the gun. Trial to firing, if there is no operation or malfunction is detected, please consult your dealer or G&G for repair.	

## **CAUTION**

Always attach the safety cap and disconnect the magazine to avoid sudden operation upon connecting the battery.

Be careful so as not to hurt your fingers in the movable parts.

Always set the lever to "safe" before firing.

Do not disassemble beyond what is necessary, or the gun may be damaged.

Always use "G&G ARMAMENT" BBs for this gun. We shall not be held responsible for any damage or accidents arising from the use of bullets supplied by other manufacturers.

Since a tight barrel is used, use of dirty BBs or those with burrs causes jamming and possible fatal damage to the gear box.

Turning hop-up dial excessively causes clogging of BBs in the hop-up chamber. Continuos pulling of the trigger with clogged BBs will damage the piston and the gears.

Never hold the gun sideways as BBs will curve right or left.

We shall not be held responsible for any damage or accidents arising from the wrong operation or modification of the gun.

Disassembly is designed for appropriate maintenance, not for modification.
